

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Lenzie Road, Stepps**  
**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012**

On 30 July 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage works) on Lenzie Road, Stepps from the extended line of the southern kerb of Anniesland Avenue to the extended line of the southern kerb of Church Avenue by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed northwards then north eastwards on Lenzie Road, north eastwards on B757 Stepps Road, south westwards and south eastwards on the A806, south westwards on A80 Cumbernauld Road and northwards on Lenzie Road to the south side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practical, by arrangement with the contractor.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0930 hours on Monday, 20 August 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 14 October 2012.

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Lenzie Road, Stepps) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012" and shall be effective during the period from 0930 hours on Monday, the twentieth day of August, Two thousand and twelve until 2359 hours on Sunday, the fourteenth day of October, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage works) on Lenzie Road, Stepps from the extended line of the southern kerb of Anniesland Avenue to the extended line of the southern kerb of Church Avenue, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.
