

North Lanarkshire Council
Various Streets, Motherwell Town Centre
(Temporary Closure) Order 2012

On 17 September 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on the under-noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Phase 1

Merry Street, Motherwell from the extended line of the eastern kerb of West Hamilton Street, north eastwards for a distance of 170 metres or thereby.

Pollock Street, Motherwell from the extended line of the north western kerb of Merry Street, northwards for a distance of 60 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Pollock Street on the north east side of the closure wishing to access Merry Street on the south west side of the closure should proceed northwards on Pollock Street, south eastwards on Mentieth Road and south westwards then north westwards on West Hamilton Street to the south west side of the closure.

Both car parks at Pollock Street will be accessible throughout the duration of the works.

Phase 2

Hamilton Road, Motherwell from the extended line of the western kerb of West Hamilton Street, south westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Avon Street, a distance of 140 metres or thereby.

High Road, Motherwell from its junction with Hamilton Road, northwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Hamilton Road on the south west side of the closure wishing to access West Hamilton Street on the north east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Hamilton Road, eastwards on Airbles Road, north westwards on Windmillhill Street and Brandon Street and south westwards then north westwards on West Hamilton Street to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on West Hamilton Street on the north east side of the closure wishing to access Hamilton Road on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Hamilton Road on the south west side of the closure wishing to access High Road on the north side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Hamilton Road, north westwards on Orchard Street, north eastwards on Ladywell Road, south eastwards on Farm Street and southwards on High Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on High Road on the north side of the closure wishing to access Hamilton Road on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on High Road on the north side of the closure wishing to access West Hamilton Street on the north east side of the closure should proceed northwards on High Road, north westwards on Farm Street, south westwards on Ladywell Road, south eastwards on Orchard Street, south westwards on Hamilton Road, eastwards on Airbles Road, north westwards on Windmillhill Street and Brandon Street and south westwards then north westwards on West Hamilton Street to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on West Hamilton Street on the north east side of the closure wishing to access High Road on the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access to adjoining properties will be maintained by arrangement with the contractor.

These works will be phased, with no two closures taking place at the same time.

The Order, which will be operational only when signing is in place, will be effective from 1800 hours on Saturdays until 2359 hours on Sundays only, will come into operation at 1800 hours on Saturday, 29 September 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 28 October 2012.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2012

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Motherwell Town Centre) (Temporary Closure) Order 2012” and shall be effective only when signing is in place and from 1800 hours on Saturdays until 2359 hours on Sundays only, during the period from 1800 hours on Saturday, the twenty-ninth day of September, Two thousand and twelve until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty-eighth day of October, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on the under-noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Phase 1

Merry Street, Motherwell from the extended line of the eastern kerb of West Hamilton Street, north eastwards for a distance of 170 metres or thereby.

Pollock Street, Motherwell from the extended line of the north western kerb of Merry Street, northwards for a distance of 60 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Pollock Street on the north east side of the closure wishing to access Merry Street on the south west side of the closure should proceed northwards on Pollock Street, south eastwards on Mentieth Road and south westwards then north westwards on West Hamilton Street to the south west side of the closure.

Both car parks at Pollock Street will be accessible throughout the duration of the works.

Phase 2

Hamilton Road, Motherwell from the extended line of the western kerb of West Hamilton Street, south westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Avon Street, a distance of 140 metres or thereby.

High Road, Motherwell from its junction with Hamilton Road, northwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Hamilton Road on the south west side of the closure wishing to access West Hamilton Street on the north east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Hamilton Road, eastwards on Airbles Road, north westwards on Windmillhill Street and Brandon Street and south westwards then north westwards on West Hamilton Street to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on West Hamilton Street on the north east side of the closure wishing to access Hamilton Road on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Hamilton Road on the south west side of the closure wishing to access High Road on the north side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Hamilton Road, north westwards on Orchard Street, north eastwards on Ladywell Road, south eastwards on Farm Street and southwards on High Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on High Road on the north side of the closure wishing to access Hamilton Road on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on High Road on the north side of the closure wishing to access West Hamilton Street on the north east side of the closure should proceed northwards on High Road, north westwards on Farm Street, south westwards on Ladywell Road, south eastwards on Orchard Street, south westwards on Hamilton Road, eastwards on Airbles Road, north westwards on Windmillhill Street and Brandon Street and south westwards then north westwards on West Hamilton Street to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on West Hamilton Street on the north east side of the closure wishing to access High Road on the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access to adjoining properties will be maintained by arrangement with the contractor.

These works will be phased, with no two closures taking place at the same time.
