Unnamed Footpath at Telford Road, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2012

On 1 October 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge replacement works) on the unnamed footpath from where it joins the north east end of Telford Road, Cumbernauld, north eastwards for a distance of 74 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on the unnamed footpath (leading towards Kelvin Road North) and north eastwards then north westwards on the unnamed footpath (leading to the footbridge) to the north east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed vice-versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 22 October 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 31 March 2013.

Unnamed Footpath at Telford Road, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2012

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Unnamed Footpath at Telford Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012”, shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty second day of October, Two thousand and twelve until 2359 hours on Sunday, the thirty first day of March, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge replacement works) on the unnamed footpath from where it joins the north east end of Telford Road, Cumbernauld, north eastwards for a distance of 74 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on the unnamed footpath (leading towards Kelvin Road North) and north eastwards then north westwards on the unnamed footpath (leading to the footbridge) to the north east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed vice-versa.
