Bellziehill Roundabout (Southern Bridgedeck), Bellshill

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013

On 11 February 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on waterproofing works) on the southern bridgedeck of Bellziehill Roundabout, Bellshill from the extended line of the western kerb of A725 southbound on slip road, westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of A725 northbound off slip road, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed southwards on A725 southbound on slip road, southwards then south westwards on A725 to the Raith Interchange, proceed around the Raith Interchange, exiting north eastwards then travelling north westwards and northwards on A725 exiting at the 2nd exit then proceeding northwards on the northbound off slip road to the west side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will be operational only when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 2000 hours on Friday, 1 March 2013 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 24 March 2013.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Bellziehill Roundabout (Southern Bridgedeck)) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013”, shall be operational only when signing is in place and shall be effective from 2000 hours on Friday, the first day of March, Two thousand and thirteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty-fourth day of March, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on waterproofing works) on the southern bridgedeck of Bellziehill Roundabout, Bellshill from the extended line of the western kerb of A725 southbound on slip road, westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of A725 northbound off slip road, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed southwards on A725 southbound on slip road, southwards then south westwards on A725 to the Raith Interchange, proceed around the Raith Interchange, exiting north eastwards then travelling north westwards and northwards on A725 exiting at the 2nd exit then proceeding northwards on the northbound off slip road to the west side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
