

North Lanarkshire Council
Lancaster Avenue, Chapelhall
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013

On 25 February 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the construction of sewer manholes and the installation of sewer pipes) on Lancaster Avenue, Chapelhall from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Tarbolton Crescent eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of St Abbs Way, a distance of 60 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Lancaster Avenue, north eastwards on B799 Woodhall Street and B799 Lauchope Street, south eastwards on A73 Main Street and A73 Bellside Road and south westwards on Lancaster Avenue to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 18 March 2013 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 5 April 2013.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Lancaster Avenue, Chapelhall) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the eighteenth day of March, Two thousand and thirteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the fifth day of April, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the construction of sewer manholes and the installation of sewer pipes) on Lancaster Avenue, Chapelhall from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Tarbolton Crescent eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of St Abbs Way, a distance of 60 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Lancaster Avenue, north eastwards on B799 Woodhall Street and B799 Lauchope Street, south eastwards on A73 Main Street and A73 Bellside Road and south westwards on Lancaster Avenue to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
