St Margaret's Avenue and Kelvinside Crescent, Banton, Kilsyth

(Temporary Closure) Order 2013

On 25 February 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the resurfacing of the footways and carriageway and kerbing repairs) on the under-noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Location 1

St Margaret's Avenue, Banton from its junction with Kelvinhead Road, north eastwards and northwards to its junction with Mailings Road.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Mailings Road and south eastwards on Main Street to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 2

Kelvinside Crescent, Banton over its entire length.

Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.

Vehicular and pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order, which will be effective only when signage is in place, will come into operation at 0800 hours on Monday, 18 March 2013 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Friday, 29 March 2013.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2013

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (St Margaret's Avenue and Kelvinside Crescent, Banton, Kilsyth) (Temporary Closure) Order 2013" shall be operational only when signing is in place and shall be effective during the period from 0800 hours on Monday, the eighteenth day of March, Two thousand and thirteen until 1800 hours on Friday, the twenty-ninth day of March, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the resurfacing of the footways and carriageway and kerbing repairs) on the under-noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Location 1

St Margaret's Avenue, Banton from its junction with Kelvinhead Road, north eastwards and northwards to its junction with Mailings Road.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Mailings Road and south eastwards on Main Street to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 2

Kelvinside Crescent, Banton over its entire length.

Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.

Vehicular and pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
