(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013

On 3 June 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on rail replacement works) on Marshall Street, Wishaw from the extended line of the north eastern kerb of Dundyvan Lane, north eastwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south west side of the closure, wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Marshall Street, south eastwards on Alexander Street, north eastwards then northwards on Dundyvan Street, northwards on Belhaven Road and south westwards on Marshall Street to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 17 June 2013 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 20 October 2013.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Marshall Street, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the seventeenth day of June, two thousand and thirteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twentieth day of October, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on rail replacement works) on Marshall Street, Wishaw from the extended line of the north eastern kerb of Dundyvan Lane, north eastwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south west side of the closure, wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Marshall Street, south eastwards on Alexander Street, north eastwards then northwards on Dundyvan Street, northwards on Belhaven Road and south westwards on Marshall Street to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
