(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013

On 20 May 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the replacement of the existing rail bridge) on Glencairn Avenue, Craigneuk from the extended line of the north eastern kerb of Gateside Road, north eastwards to its termination a distance of 50 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Wednesday, 12 June 2013 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 11 August 2013.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Glencairn Avenue, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Wednesday, the twelfth day of June, Two thousand and thirteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the eleventh day of August, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the replacement of the existing rail bridge) on Glencairn Avenue, Craigneuk from the extended line of the north eastern kerb of Gateside Road, north eastwards to its termination a distance of 50 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
