

North Lanarkshire Council
Arns Road, Cumbernauld
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013

On 18 February 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on installation of a new high power electricity cable) on Arns Road, Cumbernauld from its junction with Forest Road, south eastwards for a distance of 800 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling south westwards on Forest Road at the west side of the closure wishing to access Arns Road at the east side of the closure should continue south westwards on Forest Road and Lenziemill Road, south eastwards on A73 Stirling Road, north eastwards on B803 Greengairs Road, north westwards on Fannyside Road, north eastwards on Garbethill Road and north westwards then eastwards on Arns Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles travelling north eastwards on Forest Road at the west side of the closure wishing to access Arns Road at the east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Forest Road to Whitelees roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit and travel south westwards on Forest Road and Lenziemill Road, south eastwards on A73 Stirling Road, north eastwards on B803 Greengairs Road, north westwards on Fannyside Road, north eastwards on Garbethill Road and north westwards then eastwards on Arns Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 11 March 2013 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 7 July 2013.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Arns Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013, shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the eleventh day of March, Two thousand and thirteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the seventh day of July, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on installation of a new high power electricity cable) on Arns Road, Cumbernauld from its junction with Forest Road, south eastwards for a distance of 800 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling south westwards on Forest Road at the west side of the closure wishing to access Arns Road at the east side of the closure should continue south westwards on Forest Road and Lenziemill Road, south eastwards on A73 Stirling Road, north eastwards on B803 Greengairs Road, north westwards on Fannyside Road, north eastwards on Garbethill Road and north westwards then eastwards on Arns Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles travelling north eastwards on Forest Road at the west side of the closure wishing to access Arns Road at the east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Forest Road to Whitelees roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit and travel south westwards on Forest Road and Lenziemill Road, south eastwards on A73 Stirling Road, north eastwards on B803 Greengairs Road, north westwards on Fannyside Road, north eastwards on Garbethill Road and north westwards then eastwards on Arns Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
