On 5 August 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, made the above-named Order to be observed by vehicles between 1201 hours and 2359 hours on Friday, 23 August 2013, the Order being notified on the roads by the use of Police "No Waiting" cones.
