B8039 Blackbog Road and B8039 Northbound Off Slip Road to Blackbog Road, Airdrie (Temporary Road Closure) Order No 2 2013

On 6 August 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge refurbishment works) on B8039 Blackbog Road and B8039 Northbound Off Slip Road to Blackbog Road, Airdrie from the extended line of the western kerb of A73 Stirling Road, north westwards on the A73 northbound off slip road to its junction with B8039 Blackbog Road and north eastwards on Blackbog Road from the extended line of the western kerb of the A73 Northbound Off Slip Road to the extended line of western kerb of A73 southbound off slip, a total distance of 175 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling north westwards on A73 Stirling Road wishing to access the east side of the closure should continue north westwards on A73 Stirling Road to The Chapelton roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit onto A73 Stirling Road travelling south eastwards to B8039 southbound off slip road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure on Blackbog Road wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Blackbog Road, north westwards on Cullochrigg Road, south westwards on Gain and Shankburn Road, north westwards then north eastwards on B802 Condorrat Road, north eastwards on Chapelton Road, south eastwards on A73 Stirling Road to B8039 southbound off slip road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure on B8039 Blackbog Road wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on B8039 Blackbog Road, south eastwards on B8039 Stirling Road, south eastwards on A73 Stirling Road, south westwards on Brackenhirst Road, northwards on B802 Condorrat Road, south eastwards on Gain and Shankburn Road, north eastwards then south eastwards on Cullochrigg Road and north eastwards on Blackbog Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling north westwards on A73 Stirling Road wishing to access the west side of the closure on Blackbog Road should continue north westwards on A73 Stirling Road to the Chapelton roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit travelling south westwards on Chapelton Road, south eastwards on B802 Condorrat Road, south eastwards on Gain and Shankburn Road, north eastwards and south eastwards on Cullochrigg Road and north eastwards on Blackbog Road to the west side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which continues the restrictions currently in place by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Monday, 1 July 2013, will come into operation at 2359 hours on Sunday, 18 August 2013 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Saturday, 31 August 2013.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order No 2 2013

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (B8039 Blackbog Road and B8039 Northbound Off Slip Road to Blackbog Road, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order No 2 2013" and continues the restrictions currently in place by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Monday, the first day of July, Two thousand and thirteen, shall be effective during the period from 2359 hours on Sunday, the eighteenth day of August, Two thousand and thirteen until 2359 hours on Saturday, the thirty first day of August, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge refurbishment works) on B8039 Blackbog Road and B8039 Northbound Off Slip Road to Blackbog Road, Airdrie from the extended line of the western kerb of A73 Stirling Road, north westwards on the A73 northbound off slip road to its junction with B8039 Blackbog Road and north eastwards on Blackbog Road from the extended line of the western kerb of the A73 Northbound Off Slip Road to the extended line of western kerb of A73 southbound off slip, a total distance of 175 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling north westwards on A73 Stirling Road wishing to access the east side of the closure should continue north westwards on A73 Stirling Road to The Chapelton roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit onto A73 Stirling Road travelling south eastwards to B8039 southbound off slip road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure on Blackbog Road wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Blackbog Road, north westwards on Cullochrigg Road, south westwards on Gain and Shankburn Road, north westwards then north eastwards on B802 Condorrat Road, north eastwards on Chapelton Road, south eastwards on A73 Stirling Road to B8039 southbound off slip road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure on B8039 Blackbog Road wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on B8039 Blackbog Road, south eastwards on B8039 Stirling Road, south eastwards on A73 Stirling Road, south westwards on Brackenhist Road, northwards on B802 Condorrat Road, south eastwards on Gain and Shankburn Road, north eastwards then south eastwards on Cullochrigg Road and north eastwards on Blackbog Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling north westwards on A73 Stirling Road wishing to access the west side of the closure on Blackbog Road should continue north westwards on A73 Stirling Road to the Chapelton roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit travelling south westwards on Chapelton Road, south eastwards on B802 Condorrat Road, south eastwards on Gain and Shankburn Road, north eastwards and south eastwards on Cullochrigg Road and north eastwards on Blackbog Road to the west side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
