**Stirling Street, Airdrie**

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013**

On 30 September 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on Stirling Street, Airdrie from the extended line of the western kerb of B802 Broomknoll Street, westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Wellwynd, a distance of 115 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed northwards on B802 Bank Street, north westwards on B802 South Bridge Street, south westwards on A8010 High Street and south eastwards then southwards on Wellwynd to the west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Stirling Street, south eastwards and eastwards on A89 Weaver Road and northwards on B802 Broomknoll Street to the east side of the closure.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will be effective only on Sundays between 0800 hours and 2000 hours, will come into operation at 0800 hours on Sunday, 20 October 2013 and will remain in operation until 2000 hours on Sunday, 10 November 2013.

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Stirling Street, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013”, shall be effective on Sundays during the period from 0800 hours and 2000 hours, and will come into operation on Sunday, the twentieth day of October, Two thousand and thirteen until Sunday, the tenth day of November, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on Stirling Street, Airdrie from the extended line of the western kerb of B802 Broomknoll Street, westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Wellwynd, a distance of 115 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed northwards on B802 Bank Street, north westwards on B802 South Bridge Street, south westwards on A8010 High Street and south eastwards then southwards on Wellwynd to the west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Stirling Street, south eastwards and eastwards on A89 Weaver Road and northwards on B802 Broomknoll Street to the east side of the closure.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
