B8053 North Biggar Road, Airdrie
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013

On 23 December 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer connection works) on B8053 North Biggar Road, Airdrie from a point 140 metres or thereby, north of its junction with A89 Clark Street, north eastwards to a point 33 metres or thereby, south west of the extended line of the southern kerb of Drumbathie Road, a distance of 52 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on North Biggar Road, eastwards on A89 Clark Street, north eastwards on Springwells Avenue, westwards on Drumbathie Road and south eastwards on B8053 North Biggar Road to the north west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on North Biggar Road, south westwards on Flowerhill Street, south eastwards on Knox Street, eastwards on Clark Street and north westwards on North Biggar Road to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Schedule I of the Strathclyde Regional Council (North and South Biggar Road, Airdrie) (One-Way) Order 1978 in so far as it relates to North Biggar Road, Airdrie will be temporarily revoked as part of this Order.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 6 January 2014, and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 9 February 2014.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (B8053 North Biggar Road, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the sixth day of January, Two thousand and fourteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the ninth day of February, Two thousand and fourteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer connection works) on B8053 North Biggar Road, Airdrie from a point 140 metres or thereby, north of its junction with A89 Clark Street, north eastwards to a point 33 metres or thereby, south west of the extended line of the southern kerb of Drumbathie Road, a distance of 52 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on North Biggar Road, eastwards on A89 Clark Street, north eastwards on Springwells Avenue, westwards on Drumbathie Road and south eastwards on B8053 North Biggar Road to the north west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on North Biggar Road, south westwards on Flowerhill Street, south eastwards on Knox Street, eastwards on Clark Street and north westwards on North Biggar Road to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Schedule I of the Strathclyde Regional Council (North and South Biggar Road, Airdrie) (One-Way) Order 1978 in so far as it relates to North Biggar Road, Airdrie will be temporarily revoked as part of this Order.
