

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Westerhill Road, Bishopbriggs**  
**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013**

On 23 December 2013 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot or drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of pedestrians and vehicles engaged on the Construction of a Roundabout in association with the Bishopbriggs Relief Road) on the southbound and eastbound carriageway of Westerhill Road, Bishopbriggs (at its boundary with East Dunbartonshire Council) from its junction with B812 Robroyston Road, westwards, north westwards and northwards to a point 538 metres or thereby north of the extended line of the northern kerb of Wester Cleddens Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative route: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north westwards and westwards on Westerhill Road, south westwards and southwards on A803 Kirkintilloch Road and north eastwards on B812 Auchinairn Road to the east side of the closure.*

Local access will be maintained at all times throughout the duration of the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Tuesday, 7 January 2014 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 28 February 2014.

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Westerhill Road, Bishopbriggs) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2013” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Tuesday, the seventh day of January, Two thousand and fourteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-eighth day of February, Two thousand and fourteen.
2. No person shall proceed on foot or drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of pedestrians and vehicles engaged on the Construction of a Roundabout in association with the Bishopbriggs Relief Road) on the southbound and eastbound carriageways of Westerhill Road, Bishopbriggs (at its boundary with East Dunbartonshire Council) from its junction with B812 Robroyston Road, westwards, north westwards and northwards to a point 538 metres or thereby north of the extended line of the northern kerb of Wester Cleddens Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.
