

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Rosebank Terrace, Bargeddie**  
**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014**

On 10 February the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge replacement works) on Rosebank Terrace, Bargeddie from its junction with Langmuir Road, westwards for a distance of 35 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling north westwards on Langmuir Road wishing to access Rosebank Terrace on the west side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Langmuir Road, south westwards on Dykehead Road and eastwards on Rosebank Terrace to the west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the west side of the closure on Rosebank Terrace wishing to access the east side of the closure on Langmuir Road should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles travelling south eastwards on Langmuir Road wishing to access Rosebank Terrace on the east side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Langmuir Road, proceed around the roundabout at Barrbridge Road and exit and proceed north westwards on Langmuir Road, south westwards on Dykehead Road and eastwards on Rosebank Terrace to the west side of the closure.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0930 hours on Monday, 24 February 2014 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Wednesday, 6 August 2014.

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Rosebank Terrace, Bargeddie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014” and shall be effective during the period from 0930 hours on Monday, the twenty-fourth day of February, Two thousand and fourteen until 2359 hours on Wednesday, the sixth day of August, Two thousand and fourteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge replacement works) on Rosebank Terrace, Bargeddie from its junction with Langmuir Road, westwards for a distance of 35 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling north westwards on Langmuir Road wishing to access Rosebank Terrace on the west side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Langmuir Road, south westwards on Dykehead Road and eastwards on Rosebank Terrace to the west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the west side of the closure on Rosebank Terrace wishing to access the east side of the closure on Langmuir Road should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles travelling south eastwards on Langmuir Road wishing to access Rosebank Terrace on the east side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Langmuir Road, proceed around the roundabout at Barrbridge Road and exit and proceed north westwards on Langmuir Road, south westwards on Dykehead Road and eastwards on Rosebank Terrace to the west side of the closure.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
