Coursington Road, Motherwell
(Temporary One Way) Order No 2 2014

On 9 June 2014 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, to be observed by vehicles on Coursington Road, Motherwell with travel restricted to one way north eastwards from its junction with Park Street, to its junction with Dalziel Street, a distance of 220 metres or thereby.

The Order, which continues the restrictions currently in place by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Monday, 18 November 2013, and which will only be effective when signage is in place, will come into operation at 2359 hours on Sunday, 29 June 2014 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 31 May 2015.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Coursington Road, Motherwell) (Temporary One Way) Order 2014” which continues the restrictions currently in place by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Monday, the eighteenth day of November, Two thousand and thirteen, which will only be valid when signage is in place and shall be effective during the period from 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty ninth day of June, Two thousand and fourteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the thirty-first day of May, Two thousand and fifteen.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle south westwards on Coursington Road, Motherwell with travel restricted to one way north eastwards from its junction with Park Street, to its junction with Dalziel Street, a distance of 220 metres or thereby.
