Dee Street, Coatbridge

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014

On 23 June 2014 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas mains replacement works) on Dee Street, Coatbridge from its junction with Lomond Road, southwards to its junction with Tantallon Drive, a distance of 80 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling westwards on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should continue westwards on Lomond Road, south westwards and southwards on Tay Street, eastwards on Leven Road and northwards and eastwards on Tantallon Drive, to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling eastwards on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should continue eastwards and south eastwards on Lomond Road, north westwards on Townhead Road and northwards and eastwards on Tantallon Drive, to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling westwards on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should continue westwards and southwards on Tantallon Drive, westwards on Leven Road, northwards and north eastwards on Tay Street and eastwards on Lomond Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling eastwards on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should continue eastwards on Tantallon Drive, southwards on Wye Crescent, westwards on Leven Road and northwards and north eastwards on Tay Street and eastwards on Lomond Road to the north side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0930 hours on Monday, 7 July 2014 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 27 July 2014.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Dee Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014” and shall be effective during the period from 0930 hours on Monday, the seventh day of July, two thousand and fourteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty-seventh day of July, Two thousand and fourteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas mains replacement works) on Dee Street, Coatbridge from its junction with Lomond Road, southwards to its junction with Tantallon Drive, a distance of 80 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling westwards on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should continue westwards on Lomond Road, south westwards and southwards on Tay Street, eastwards on Leven Road and northwards and eastwards on Tantallon Drive, to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling eastwards on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should continue eastwards and south eastwards on Lomond Road, north westwards on Townhead Road and northwards and eastwards on Tantallon Drive, to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling westwards on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should continue westwards and southwards on Tantallon Drive, westwards on Leven Road, northwards and north eastwards on Tay Street and eastwards on Lomond Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling eastwards on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should continue eastwards on Tantallon Drive, southwards on Wye Crescent, westwards on Leven Road and northwards and north eastwards on Tay Street and eastwards on Lomond Road to the north side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
