(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2014

On 30 June 2014 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on mine shaft repair works) on the Ballochney Road footpath, Plains from its junction with Arbuckle Road, north westwards then south westwards to its junction with Heatheryford Gardens, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed southwards on Arbuckle Road and westwards on Heatheryford Gardens to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 14 July 2014 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 27 March 2016.

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2014

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Ballochney Road, Plains) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2014” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fourteenth day of July, Two thousand and fourteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty seventh day of March, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on mine shaft repair works) on the Ballochney Road footpath, Plains from its junction with Arbuckle Road, north westwards then south westwards to its junction with Heatheryford Gardens, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed southwards on Arbuckle Road and westwards on Heatheryford Gardens to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
