**Unnamed Footpath East of Cumbernauld Train Station, South Carbrain Road,
Cumbernauld**

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2014

On 25 August 2014 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on the construction of a new ramp) on the unnamed footpath east of the Cumbernauld Train Station from its junction with the paved area east of the station building, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on the footway to Glencryan Road, north westwards on the footpath leading to Kilbowie Road, south westwards on the footpath to South Carbrain Road and south eastwards on the footpath to the south west side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Thursday, 18 September 2014 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 19 December 2014.

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2014

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Unnamed Footpath East of Cumbernauld Train Station, South Carbrain Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2014” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Thursday, the eighteenth day of September, Two thousand and fourteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the nineteenth day of December, Two thousand and fourteen.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on the construction of a new ramp) on the unnamed footpath east of the Cumbernauld Train Station from its junction with the paved area east of the station building, south westwards for a distance of 57 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on the footway to Glencryan Road, north westwards on the footpath leading to Kilbowie Road, south westwards on the footpath to South Carbrain Road and south eastwards on the footpath to the south west side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
