

North Lanarkshire Council
Napier Road, Cumbernauld
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014

On 8 September 2014 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing) on Napier Road, Cumbernauld from a point 87 metres or thereby south west of the extended line of the western kerb of the western junction of Napier Place to the extended line of the western kerb of the eastern junction of Napier Place, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the southwest side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Napier Road, south eastwards on Wyndford Road, south westwards on B816 Castlecary Road and north westwards, south westwards, north westwards and north eastwards on Napier Road to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 29 September 2014 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 12 October 2014.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Napier Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty ninth day of September, Two thousand and fourteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twelfth day of October, Two thousand and fourteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing) on Napier Road, Cumbernauld from a point 87 metres or thereby south west from the extended line of the western kerb of the west junction of Napier Place to the extended line of the western kerb of the eastern junction of Napier Place, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Napier Road, south eastwards on Wyndford Road, south westwards on B816 Castlecary Road, north westwards, south westwards, north westwards and north eastwards on Napier Road to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
