

North Lanarkshire Council
Millcroft Road, Riggend
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014

On 29 September 2014 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of power cables) on Millcroft Road, Riggend from its junction with Summerhill and Garngibbock Road, eastwards, south eastwards and north eastwards to the extended line of the western side of the car park access at Millcroft Steadings, a distance of 265 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed south westwards and south eastwards on Summerhill and Garngibbock Road, southwards on the B802 Condorrat Road, north eastwards on Brackenhirst Road, northwards on A73 Stirling Road, exit via the B8039 slip road to B8039 Blackbog Road and proceed eastwards on B8039 Blackbog Road, north eastwards on B8039 Stirling Road, westwards on Millcroft Road and Spairdrum Road and north westwards then south westwards on Millcroft Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian and vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 20 October 2014 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 14 November 2014.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Millcroft Road, Riggend) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twentieth day of October, Two thousand and fourteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the fourteenth day of November, Two thousand and fourteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of power cables) on Millcroft Road, Riggend from its junction with Summerhill and Garngibbock Road, eastwards, south eastwards and north eastwards to the extended line of the western side of the car park access at Millcroft Steadings, a distance of 265 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed south westwards and south eastwards on Summerhill and Garngibbock Road, southwards on the B802 Condorrat Road, north eastwards on Brackenhirst Road, northwards on A73 Stirling Road, exit via the B8039 slip road to B8039 Blackbog Road and proceed eastwards on B8039 Blackbog Road, north eastwards on B8039 Stirling Road, westwards on Millcroft Road and Spairdrum Road and north westwards then south westwards on Millcroft Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian and vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
