

North Lanarkshire Council
Heathery Road, Wishaw
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014

On 20 October 2014 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water main upgrade works) on Heathery Road, Wishaw from its junction with Glasgow Road, north eastwards to the extended line of the southern kerb of Campsie Road, a distance of 125 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Heathery Road, south eastwards on Main Street, southwards on Cleland Road and south westwards on Glasgow Road to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure by arrangement with the contractor.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Tuesday, 4 November 2014 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 30 November 2014.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Heathery Road, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Tuesday, the fourth day of November, Two thousand and fourteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the thirtieth day of November, Two thousand and fourteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water main upgrade works) on Heathery Road, Wishaw from its junction with Glasgow Road, north eastwards to the extended line of the southern kerb of Campsie Road, a distance of 125 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Heathery Road, south eastwards on Main Street, southwards on Cleland Road and south westwards on Glasgow Road to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure by arrangement with the contractor.
