

North Lanarkshire Council
Shawstonfoot Road, Bellside, Cleland
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014

On 3 November 2014 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge maintenance works) on Shawstonfoot Road, Bellside, Cleland from a point 40 metres or thereby, north east of the northern edge of the railbridge that crosses over Shawstonfoot Road, south westwards for a distance of 80 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards then eastwards on Shawstonfoot Road, south eastwards and southwards on Murdostoun Road, south westwards on Bonkle Road, north westwards on A73 Westwood Road and the A73, south eastwards on Carlisle Road and north eastwards on Shawstonfoot Road to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will only be operational when signage is in place and will only be effective between the hours of 2200 hours and 0600 hours each day, will come into operation at 2200 hours on Saturday, 29 November 2014 and will remain in operation until 0600 hours on Friday, 5 December 2014.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Shawstonfoot Road, Bellside, Cleland) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014” which will only be operational when signage is in place and shall be effective between the hours of 2200 hours and 0600 hours each day, during the period from 2200 hours on Saturday, the twenty ninth day of November, Two thousand and fourteen until 0600 hours on Friday, the fifth day of December, Two thousand and fourteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge maintenance works) on Shawstonfoot Road, Bellside, Cleland from a point 40 metres or thereby, north east of the northern edge of the railbridge that crosses over Shawstonfoot Road, south westwards for a distance of 80 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards then eastwards on Shawstonfoot Road, south eastwards and southwards on Murdostoun Road, south westwards on Bonkle Road, north westwards on A73 Westwood Road and the A73, south eastwards on Carlisle Road and north eastwards on Shawstonfoot Road to the south west side of the closure.
