Meeting was opened by J. Telfer and the first item discussed was a letter received from SEPA on how they can improve on their services between now and the year 2040.

There is still a distinctly bad smell coming from the drains in the Motherwell Road and Newstevenston Road areas. This is in spite of the SEPA being to check the drains.

At the Hattonhill location confusion still exists, and people are unable to find the way around this area, as there are no street names showing in obvious places.

Plans were shown for the A723 from Merry Street/Motherwell Road roundabout, to Bo'ness B799. This stretch of road will be made into a dual carriageway.

It was noted that there is a good Police presence in the village at present.

A report to the council that there is a rat infestation in the Motherwell Road area, has been dealt with as the Environmental Services have been in attendance and have distributed the necessary pest control poison; they will keep a watch on the situation.
