

Minutes of Glenmavis Community Council Meeting.
Wednesday 3rd February 2010.

There were 2 apologies this evening, Margaret Anderson and Cllr S. Coyle.
The chairman (JC) asked that the minutes of the last meeting held on 4th November be adopted as true and accurate.
