

## **Minutes of Glenmavis Community Council Meeting 2/03/2011.**

Present were, J.Comrie (JC) G.Stewart (GS) F.Quay (FQ) M.Croall (MC)  
G.Baxter (GB) J.Oldroyd (JO) A.Gilmour (AG)  
Apologies – T.McCormack.

The chairman asked that the minutes of the last meeting be adopted as correct.  
These were duly proposed by GS and seconded by JO.  
The chairman asked if there were any matters arising from the last meeting.

GS reported that he had a copy of the planning permission for the fence at the new houses @ Dalmacoulter Court and this was being built to take in garden ground.  
This matter was closed.  
MC – also confirmed that as discussed at our last meeting, letters had been sent to Christine Pollock, Jim Logue, Graham Mackay and a letter to NLC re Eplanning.  
MC – submitted a receipt for the purchase of stamps to the treasurer.

### **Incoming correspondence.**

3 copies of the Community Councillor Journal and a letter of invitation to a meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> March – the invitation was declined by all present.  
This also included the annual renewal of our membership – passed to FQ to action.

2011 Diary from NLC – passed to JC.  
NLC – reply from G.Mackay re 20's plenty.  
NLC – reply from Jim Logue  
NLC – reply from Murdo Maciver.

There was a long discussion regarding the responses we had received to our letters from NLC. We anxiously await a confirmation date from Murdo Maciver who has agreed to attend one of our meetings.

Treasurers report – FQ reported that our current balance stands @ £3601.13.  
MC – enquired as to whether the DD had been organised.  
FQ – this will be organised shortly.

### **A.O.B.**

GS – distributed a copy of the bowling club logo. It was agreed that we would adapt this for our community council logo with the wording changed to suit.  
JC will now organise badges for all community councillors.

FQ – reported that her home had been broken into since our last meeting. This had occurred early in the morning, and the intruder had been disturbed by someone walking their dog in the lane.  
All agreed that we would like representation from the community police at our future meetings.  
FQ – will contact them and ask them to come along.

JO – will call NLC (A.Wyatt) re traffic calming/fence panels missing from outside church/footpath at church.

JC – also mentioned that he would like a letter sent regarding a gully cover that was missing from a large hole near the playground @ Balmoral Avenue.

(JC contacted MC the next day to say that this work had started and asked that the letter request be withdrawn)

FQ – reported that Colin from Bartletts had contacted her regarding a donation made recently of panto tickets and goody bags.

FQ – reported that the street lighting was being changed to low energy lights and moved to the other side of the road near her home which she felt was dangerous.

There was a lot of foot traffic on her side of the road and the lights at that side of the road would be missed. There seemed to be underground cables which prevented The lights being re-installed on the same side. FQ was continuing to look into this.

JC – stated that FQ had the backing of the community council and could state that in her conversations with NLC/Scottish Power, all present agreed with this.

There was discussion around having our May meeting at another venue, it was agreed to postpone this decision until we had heard from Murdo Maciver.

There being no further business, the meeting was closed.
