#### Planning Applications

There are a number of applications for wind turbines.

Pearson Planning has applied for a supermarket and car parking at Carlisle Road, Airdrie.

#### Shore Energy

The appeal was upheld despite public and council opinion. The next step is to take the matter to the Court of Session. Ideas were sought to highlight the strength of opinion.

#### Car Parking Charges

As well as the town centre car parks, NLC own some of the railway car parks. Charges for these will not be refundable against fares, as they are in railway owned car parks. This does not encourage the use of public transport.

#### Bowhouse Bridge

The bridge is in a dangerous condition. There will be a meeting held in the Civic Centre on 14 June if anyone can attend.

#### Community Nature Park

NLC will not fence the ponds off fully. Can we ask for support with the cost warning notices? Two planting events were held in February and March when trees and bulbs were put in.

#### Scottish Water, Monkland Estate

Renewal of the water mains is under way and many residents are without water for large parts of the day.
