He stated that the Village had minimal crime levels over the last four weeks with only four reports to the Police, including street drinking and a birthday party that got out of hand due to under age drinking resulting in a disturbance.

PC Morrison will meet with door staff of the license premises to discuss the monitoring of guests coming in and exiting the premises at future events.

A resident asked if the weight limit currently operating in The Wynd was being exceeded by a double decker bus moving through The Wynd every morning at approx 8.30am en route to picking up schoolchildren. PC Morrison indicated that he would investigate.
