1.0 Introduction

1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide members of Bellshill Area Committee with the second of regular monitoring reports detailing community grants awarded in the Bellshill area through the Interim Community Grants Scheme and during the period April 1997 to February 1998.

2.0 Background

2.1 Bellshill Area Committee at its meeting on 11 December 1997 received the first of such Monitoring Reports submitted by the Chief Executive. This report summarised the Interim Community Grant Awards granted within Bellshill area during the period April to October 1997.

3.0 Interim Community Grant Awards - April 1997 to February 1998

3.1 This report consolidates those grants awards during the period April to October 1997 and summarised in the previous report, alongwith grants subsequently awarded during the period October 1997 to date.

3.2 Number of Awards and Type of Organisation

3.3 Appendix One to this report provides a table listing all Bellshill area grant award recipients during the period April 1997 to February 1998. The table also lists the level of funding awarded and the type of organisation, for example youth groups, pre 5 groups and organisations for elderly people. Within these categories football and other sporting activities for children and young people are categorised as "Youth". The "General" category includes for example, hobby and arts based groups.


3.4 From the key code and graph provided in Appendix One it can be seen that the largest single category supported through the Interim Community Grants Scheme is organisations for young people.

3.5 Appendix Two repeats the list of grant awards during the period April 1997 to February 1998, but this time lists the purpose for which funding was awarded, for example, equipment, administration or programme costs. The single largest category is programme and outing costs, This is linked to the awards to support elderly peoples organisations since a number of grants were awarded to enable elderly people to enjoy a special event or excursion.

3.6 The total amount awarded during the period is £26,675 and the total number of grants awarded is 128. The average grant award is £208.

4.0 Recommendation

4.1 Bellshill Area Committee is requested to note the contents of this report and the appendices.

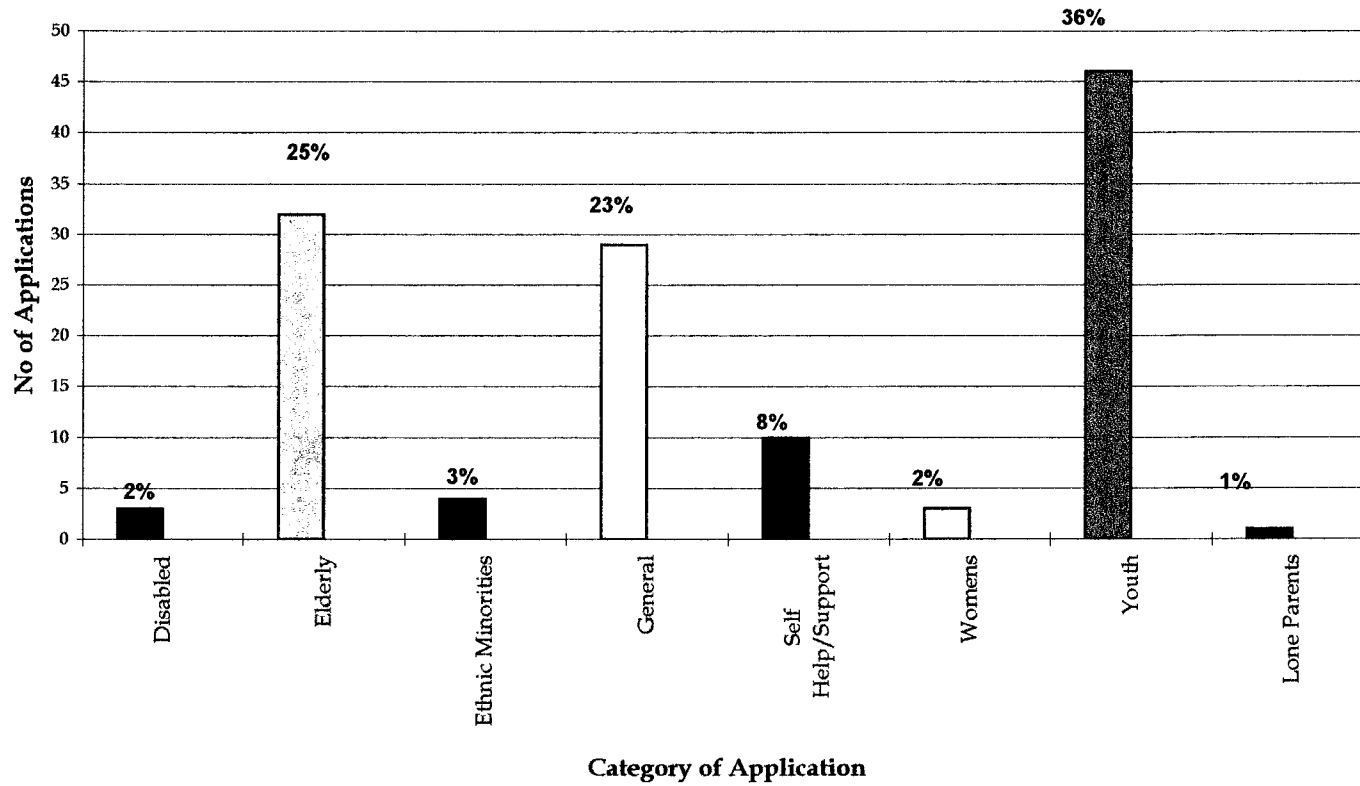
