The conference will address the full range of business opportunities available in South Africa, focusing on:

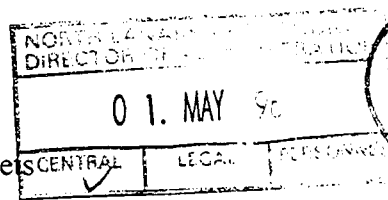
- * direct investment opportunities
