CCTV schemes are now commonplace in city and town centres, across Scotland. Their application may be extended to housing developments, hospitals and schools as the wider issues of community safety and security in public places are debated by politicians, local authorities and the general public. The operation, effectiveness, accountability, and management of such schemes needs to be reviewed. This seminar will consider the fundamental issues surrounding the use and potential abuses of CCTV schemes. It will also address the key questions raised by the implementation of such schemes.

- How can the performance of CCTV be measured?
- Does CCTV work?
- Who is accountable for CCTV schemes?
- How can the abuses of CCTV be avoided?

The LGIU will also be launching in Scotland their model code of practice for CCTV schemes at the seminar. This code, which is based on research by South Bank University, London, incorporates the experience of existing schemes and includes assessment of important issues such as the relevance of the Data Protection legislation.

The seminar will be of relevance to councillors, community safety and policy officers, housing professionals and police involved in CCTV and community liaison.
