**Purpose of the Report**

1. To inform Members of the recent video filmed in North Lanarkshire showing sustainable development activity carried out by the Council and its partners under the heading of Local Agenda 21 (LA 21).

**Background**

2. As indicated at the meeting of Committee on 17 June 1998, (Item 21), the Head of Planning and Transportation chaired a Working Party on behalf of the Institution of Civil Engineers, leading to the publication of 'Local Agenda 21, Engineering the Future'. Following this, the Television Education Network (T.E.N.), approached the Department regarding the Council's Local Agenda 21 work, with the view to producing an educational training video for engineers.

As this was a good opportunity to positively promote the work of the authority, T.E.N. were invited to come and film three key projects which promote sustainable development in North Lanarkshire through LA 21. The three projects featured were Plains Country Park, Safer Routes to School and the Fuel Outreach Officer's work. The video has now been produced and a copy sent to all those who featured in it. It has been well received by the participants and the Department would like to take this opportunity to thank all those in various Council Departments and from outwith the Council who helped with the making of the video.
