SITUATION. MORE COULD AND SHOULD HAVE BEEN DONE TO INFORM  
RESIDENTS. HYDRANTS INCREASED TO 1 EVERY 5 METERS OF PIPE  
AND THIS WILL ALLOW LEAKS TO BE DETECTED AND MONITORED.  
PRESSURE COULD BE LOW.

STORM DAMAGE – THIS WILL BE CONTINUED WHEN WINDS DIE DOWN.

LIGHTS IN CLOSES – MORRISON ASKED TO CHECK.

OWNER OCCUPIERS IN FLATS MUST BE HELD TO MISSIVE AGREEMENT

MINUTES FROM MEETINGS HELD IN DEC.2001 AND JAN 2002 READ AND PASSED.

DURING THE HIGH WINDS AT THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR THE SCULPTURE AT  
SAFEMART HAD BLOWN DOWN. BETH HAD MADE ENQUIRES REGARDING THE  
NECESSITY OF RE-ERECTING THIS. PETER ADDED THAT THE SCULPTURE WOULD  
NOT BE REPLACED AND ROUNDABOUT MONO-BLOCKED OVER.

AMALGAMATION OF SCHOOLS – THIS WILL BE LONG WAY OFF AS DOCUMENTS  
HAVE NOT BE READ OR APPROVED BY COUNCILLORS. PARKING MUST BE THE  
MAIN PRIORITY OF NEW SITES BUT PETER WILL KEEP US INFORMED.

RE-HOUSING WITHIN SAME STREET CAN BE ARRANGED AS LONG AS TENANT IS  
ON THE HOUSING LIST.

BAD DRAINAGE IN PARNELL STREET CAUSING PROBLEMS IN FLATS. THE  
COMMITTEE AGREED THAT THESE FLATS SHOULD BE DEMOLISHED.

DAMAGE TO ROOFS IN HIGH WIND. PETER REPORTED THAT ROOFS ON THE FLATS  
WERE A PROBLEM, AS THEY COULD NOT GET THE MACHINERY NEAR ENOUGH TO  
REPAIR.

ONCE AGAIN PETER URGED EVERYONE WHO WAS MAKING A REPAIR CALL TO  
TAKE THE NAME OF THE OFFICER AND DATE OF COMPLAINT. THIS WOULD HELP  
IF HE HAD TO MAKE FURTHER INQUIRIES.

CLOSE CLEANING STILL A PROBLEM AS THE CONTRACTORS NOT FULFILLING THE  
JOB SPECIFICATION. PETER WANTS TO BE KEPT INFORMED.

MARY WOULD PURSUE NEWS OF AN OUTDOOR MARKET IN BURNBANK STREET.

SHOPS LYING VACANT IN AIRDRIE CENTRE RETAIL PARK. ALDI STILL OWNS ONE  
OUTLET BUT DUE TO DELIVERY DEPOT PROBLEMS THEY HAVE DECIDED TO  
LEAVE EMPTY MEANWHILE. OTHER OUTLET NO-ONE AS YET. SHOPS IN THE  
MAIN STREETS NOT CONTROLLED BY COUNCIL.

PHASE 2 OF TOWN CENTRE UPGRADE. NOT FORGOTTEN.

NEW PUBS AND A RESTURANT BUT NO NEW SHOPS.
