THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL MET WITHIN THE COMMUNITY CENTRE, WEDNESDAY 27TH FEBRUARY 2002.

CHAIRPERSON OPENED BY STATING THAT YOU WOULD SEE FROM THE ADVERT THAT THERE WERE TWO VACANCIES WITHIN THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL, BUT THESE COULD NOT BE FILLED TONIGHT AS THE ADVERT REQUIRES TO BE PLACED TWICE, AND 14 DAYS NOTICE IS ALSO REQUIRED. SHE ASKED THAT ANYONE WHO WAS INTERESTED IN JOINING THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL SHOULD FORWARD THEIR NAME TOGETHER WITH PROPOSER AND SECONDER'S NAME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. SHE ALSO ADVISED THAT THIS PROCEDURE ALSO APPLIES TO ANY PERSON WHO MAY BE A COOPTED MEMBER.

MINUTES HAD ALREADY BEEN DISTRIBUTED AND ALSO READ FOR 23RD JANUARY AND WERE APPROVED BY JOHN DAVIES SENR. AND JOHN DAVIES JUNR.

WE HAD AN EMERGENCY MEETING ON THE 14TH FEBUARY AND THE MINUTES FOR THIS MEETING WERE READ AND ADOPTED BY W. McINTYRE AND S. WHYTEMAN.

WITH REGARD TO THE PROJECTS PUT FORWARD COUNCILLOR COX REPORTED THAT SHE HAD PUT FORWARD THE PROPOSAL IN RELATION TO THE COMMUNITY CENTRE, TO DATE NO REPLY. WITH REGARDS TO THE STREET LIGHTS NOTHING FORWARD YET.

CHAIRPERSON AT THIS POINT BROUGHT TO NOTICE THE PARAGRAPH WITHIN THE MINUTES FOR THE 14TH FEBRUARY WHEN IT WAS NOTED THAT OUR COUNCILLOR WILL BE ADVISED OF ALL MEETINGS AS SHE WILL BE ABLE TO GUIDE AND HELP US IN MANY MATTERS THAT WILL BE FORTH COMING IN THE NEW SET UP. WE DO UNDERSTAND THAT THE COUNCILLOR HAS A LOT ON, BUT WE HOPE THAT SHOULD HER COMMITMENTS ALLOW HER, SHE WILL MAKE AS MANY OF THE MEETINGS THAT SHE CAN, WE DO APPRECIATE HER HELP.

HOWEVER RUSSELL LEISURE SHOULD BE CONTACTED TOGETHER WITH WILLIE BEATTIE TO HAVE THIS MATTER COMPLETELY RESOLVED AND THEN HANDED OVER TO THE COUNCIL.
