1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 A petition with over 800 signatures has been received from the chairperson of the school board of Kildrum Primary School, Cumbernauld. It complains about the proposed building of a classroom, office and reception area at the school in the foyer of the school.

2 RESPONSE

- 2.1 The adaptations referred to were associated with the development of a nursery centre in the building and the reallocation of accommodation.
- 2.2 It is clear that the school board is not fully aware of further discussions with the head teacher about the adaptations. The current plans are for the conversion of an existing library into a classroom. Therefore, work to form the additional classroom and other accommodation in the foyer has therefore been suspended.

3 RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 The education committee is asked to note the terms of the petition from the school board and the response by the education department.
