Property Surplus to Education Requirements at Kildrum Primary, Cumbernauld

Report by the Director of Education

1. Background

- 1.1 In October 2000, the education committee approved the relocation of Kildrum Primary into the buildings formally occupied by Sacred Heart Primary School. At this time it was agreed that Kildrum Nursery should remain in its existing accommodation until possible relocation options were investigated.

2. Proposals

- 2.1 The relocation of Kildrum Primary School has now taken place. The building has been vacated and boarded up. The building is no longer required for educational purposes and should be declared surplus to requirements. It is proposed that the accommodation currently used by Kildrum Nursery be retained until the investigations into possible relocation are completed. Details showing the part of the site to be retained is shown in appendix 2. A report on this matter will be submitted to the sub-committee in due course.
- 2.2 The responsibility for the vacant school building and site should be transferred to the department of housing and property services for disposal.
- 2.3 Details of the building locations and site to be declared surplus are shown in appendices 1 and 2.

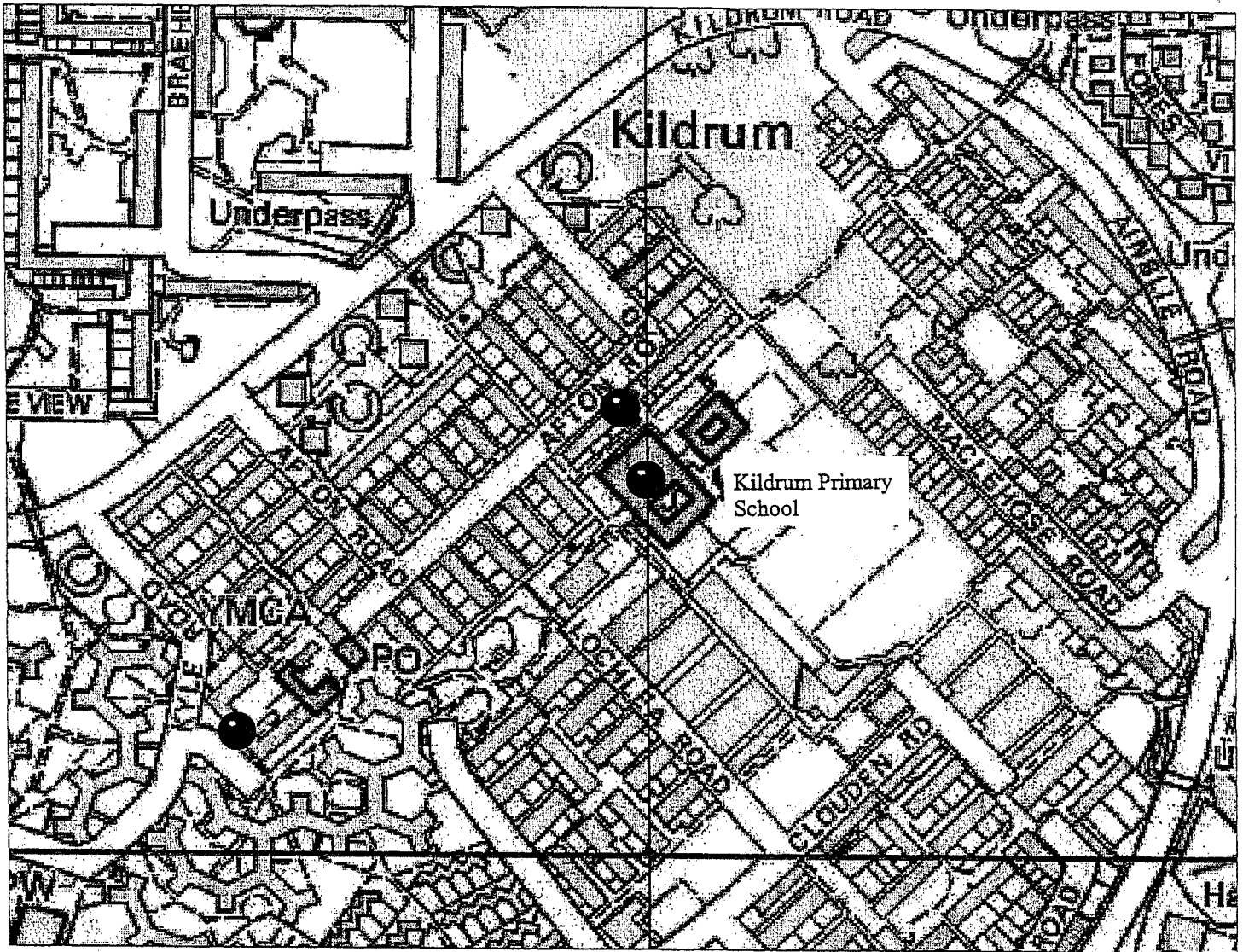
3. Recommendations

The education resources sub-committee is recommended:

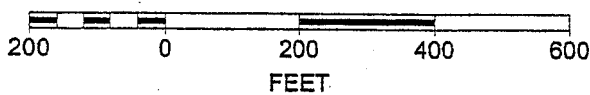
- (a) to approve that part of the building and site at Kildrum Primary School, Cumbernauld be declared surplus to educational requirements.
