
**Summary**

## **Building and site surplus to education requirements at Langlands Primary School Cumbernauld**

### **Report by the Director of Education**

#### **1. Background**

As part of the 1999 Cumbernauld rationalisation programme, the education committee decided that Langlands Primary School should be closed. The location of the school is shown in appendix 1 and 2.

- 1.1 However, as a result of a fire in Baird Memorial Primary in August 2000, the Langlands Primary building was retained to accommodate this school until a replacement school was constructed.
- 1.2 The New Baird Memorial Primary opened in January 2004 and Langlands Primary has now been vacated.

#### **2. Summary**

The education department does not have any further use for the buildings and recommends that it be declared surplus to requirements.

#### **3. Recommendations**

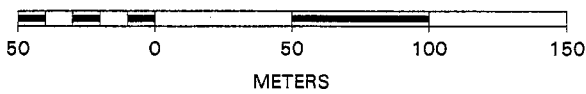

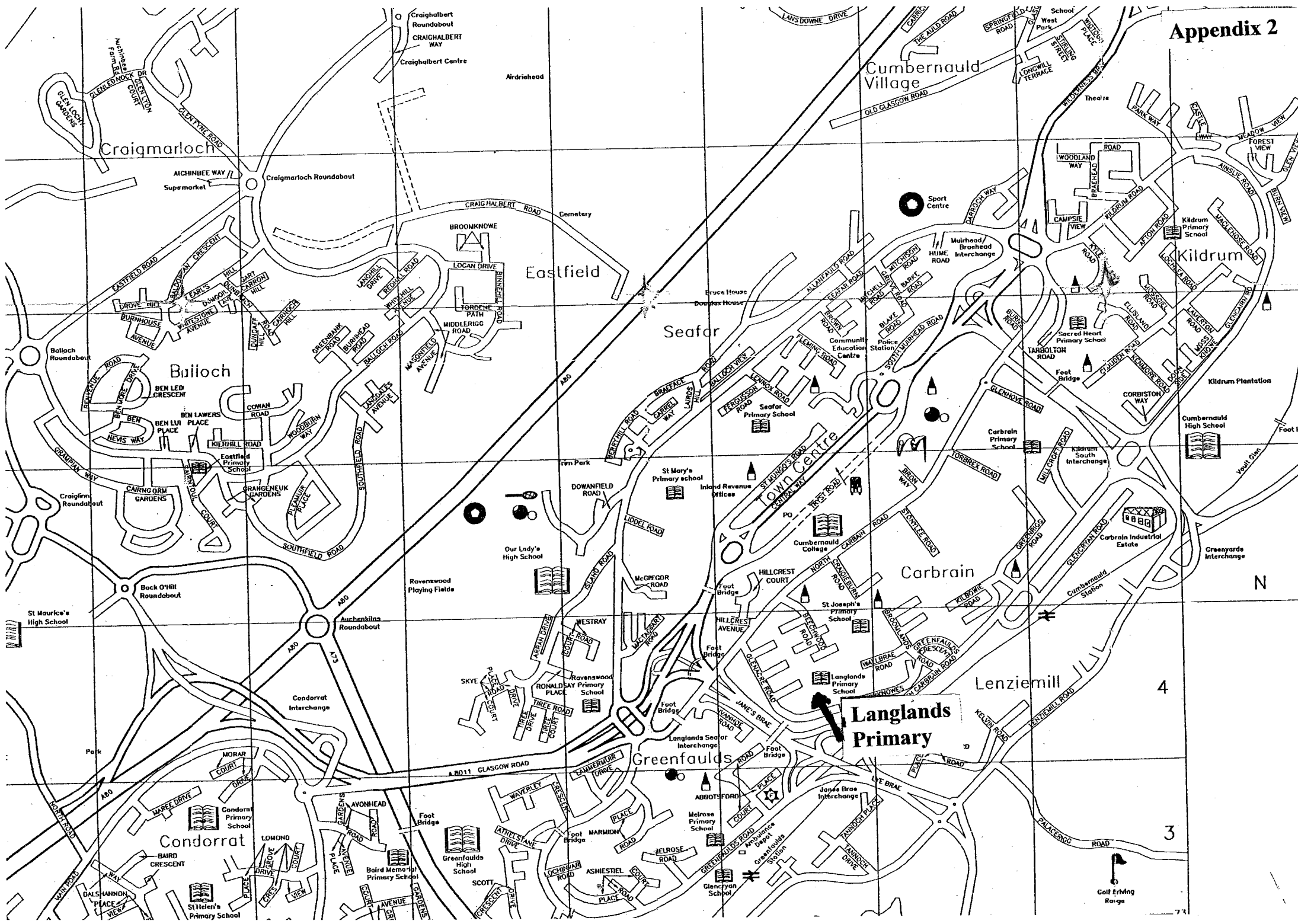
