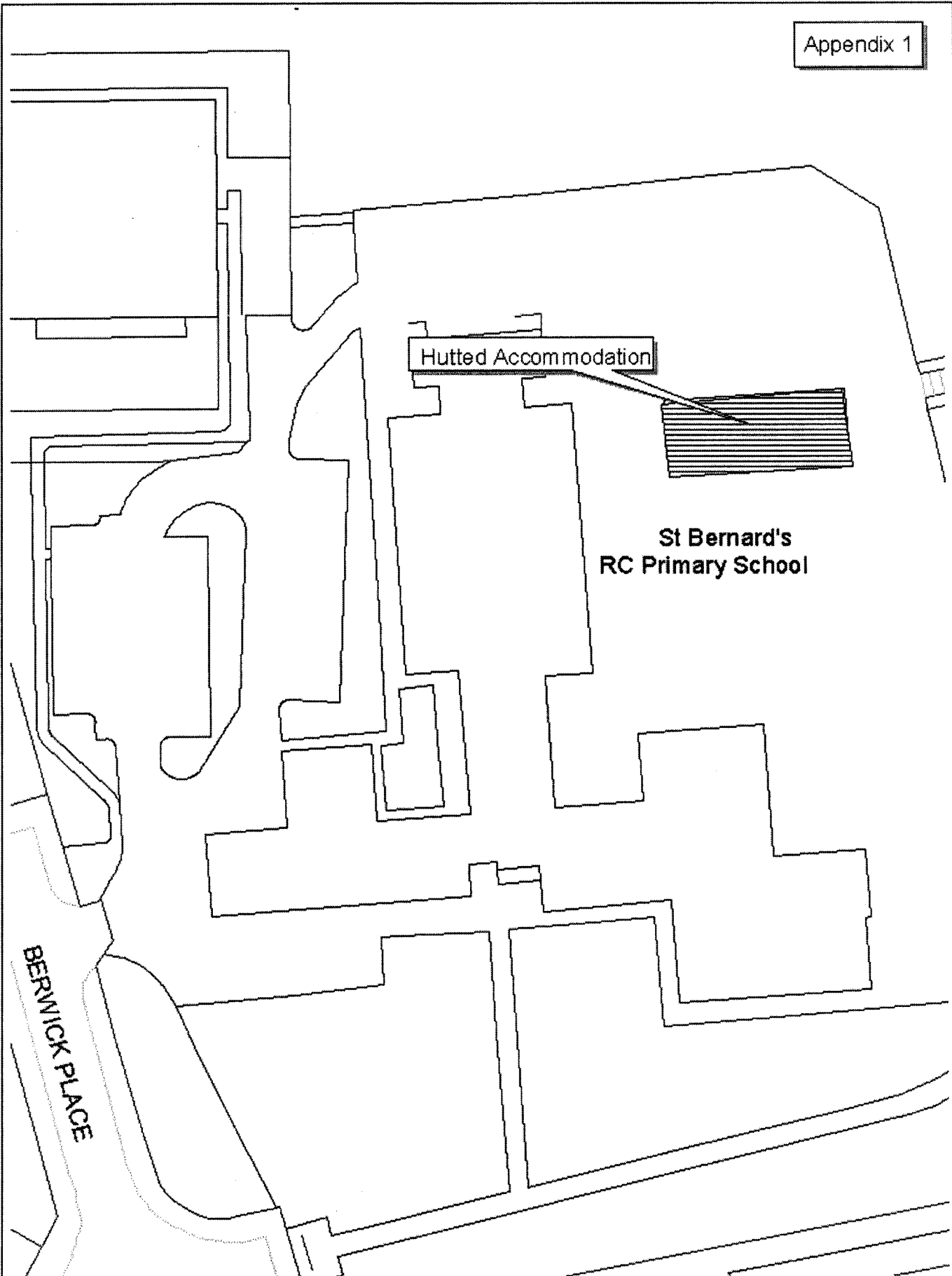
1. Background

- 1.1 At the meeting in August 2000 the education resources sub-committee, agreed procedures for disposal of hutted units in schools.
