### 1. Introduction

- 1.1 From 1 April 1996 North Lanarkshire Council will have a statutory responsibility to administer and fund the Liquor Licensing function within their area in terms of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 1976.

Specifically under Section 7, the Council must appoint and employ an officer, who must be a solicitor, to be the Clerk and also such other persons as may be necessary to assist the Clerk.

### 2. Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council appoint Mr Walter B Kilgour, the Head of Legal Services, to be the Clerk to the Licensing Board and to continue the appointment of other staff pending a further report.
