PROPOSAL TO HOLD A PUBLIC PROCESSION IN CRAIGNEUK BY THE WEST OF SCOTLAND BANDS ALLIANCE ON 21 SEPTEMBER 2002

1. There was submitted (1) a notification dated 6 September 2002 of a proposal by the West of Scotland Bands Alliance to process in Craigneuk on 21 September 2002; (2) a letter dated 10 September 2002 from Councillor Love expressing concerns in respect of the proposed procession; (3) a letter dated 17 September 2002 from Strathclyde Police formally objecting to the proposed procession, and (4) a letter dated 18 September 2002 from the organiser of the procession, formally withdrawing the notice of proposal to hold the public procession in Craigneuk on 21 September 2002.

The Head of Central Services advised orally (1) that Councillor Love's concerns could rest on the written submissions contained in his letter of 10 September 2002, although he had indicated willingness to be present if that were required, and (2) that 35 letters of representation had been received from local residents opposed to the procession.

Decided:

- (1) that the withdrawal of the notice of proposal to hold a public procession in Craigneuk on 21 September 2002 by the West of Scotland Bands Alliance be noted, and
 - (2) that, in view of the foregoing, no further action be taken.
