**1. Purpose of Report**

- 1.1 The Committee, at its meeting on 8 May 2002, having noted a report on action taken to progress issues identified following the Best Value Review of Committee and Core Services, agreed that a further report be submitted on the publication, on the Internet, of Committee minutes, agendas and reports.

**2. Current Position**

- 2.1 Work has now been completed to enable the publication of all current papers on the Internet. Those papers are, accordingly, now available on the Council's web site and, with regard to agendas and reports, are published on the Council's web site on the day on which they are issued and made available for public inspection. In addition all minutes of North Lanarkshire Council are now available and can be accessed through the web site.
- 2.2 The task of incorporating into the web site all past agendas and reports is significant. This task is, however, currently being addressed and further reports will be submitted to future meetings of the Committee on progress.

- 3.1 It is recommended that the Committee note that all current Council minutes, documents and reports which are available for public inspection are now published on the Internet and can be accessed through the Council's web site.
