**1. Introduction**

To advise Members of a consultation on a request to Post Office Ltd, by the current Subpostmaster, seeking the relocation of the Condorrat Branch of the Post Office.

**2. Background**

The Post Office are consulting on the proposal by the current Subpostmaster on the relocation of Condorrat Post Office, a distance of 250 yards, from its existing premises at 2 Airdrie Road, Condorrat to alternative premises at 16 Main Road, Condorrat. The consultation closing date is 23 January 2004.

**3. Proposals**

The Post Office advise that they support this proposal. The main reasons for supporting this move is to safeguard Post Office services in the area and the view that the move would also enable Post Office to enhance existing facilities.

**4. Recommendation**

Members are asked to note that Post Office are consulting on their proposal to relocate Condorrat Post Office, a distance of 250 yards, from its existing premises at 2 Airdrie Road, Condorrat to alternative premises at 16 Main Road, Condorrat.
