1. Introduction

To advise Members of the action taken, after consultation with the Convener, in awarding assistance in respect of a twinning visit from Meulan, France and seeking homologation in this regard.

2. Background

The recommendations of the Working Party on Twinning, approved by this Council, extend to the provision of bus hire for up to two days and appropriate civic hospitality for visits from twin towns.

3. Consideration

Correspondence had been received from the Chairperson, Kilsyth Town Twinning Association advising that a party of 31 people from Meulan would be travelling to North Lanarkshire on 29 April to 3 May 2004 and requesting assistance with the visit.

4. Proposals
