1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Committee is asked to consider and to determine the local public holidays for factories and businesses in North Lanarkshire for the year 2005.

2. LOCAL PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

2.1 The General Purposes Committee considers annually the dates to be set for local public holidays for factories and businesses. In principle, at its meeting on 7th August, 1996, the Committee agreed that the local public holidays should generally follow the patterns which had been adopted by the constituent authorities to North Lanarkshire and that has been the continuing situation in the past years.

2.2 By adopting these patterns of local public holidays, the local public holidays in North Lanarkshire in the calendar year 2005 would be as follows -

- Monday 3 and Tuesday 4 January, 2005
- Monday 28 March, 2005
- Monday 2 and Monday 30 May, 2005
- Monday 18 July, 2005
- Monday 26 September, 2005
- Monday 26 and Tuesday 27 December, 2005

3. STAFF HOLIDAYS

3.1 The determination of staff holidays is the responsibility of the Policy and Resources (Personnel Services) Sub-Committee and that Committee has, separately, determined staff holidays in accordance with an established pattern.

4. RECOMMENDATION

4.1 To agree to determine the dates specified in paragraph 2.2 above as the local public holidays for factories and businesses in North Lanarkshire in 2005.
