1. Purpose of Report

To advise Members of the action taken, after consultation with the Convener, in awarding assistance in respect of a twinning visit to Bron, France from 13-20 October 2004, and seeking homologation in this regard.

2. Background

In terms of the recommendations of the Working Party on Twinning, approved by the Council, assistance for visits to the Council's twin towns extends to £50 for the first five days or part thereof and £5 per day thereafter.

3. Consideration

Correspondence had been received from the Chairperson, Cumbernauld/Bron Twinning Association advising that a party of 10 members would be travelling to Bron, France from 13-20 October 2004 and requesting assistance with the visit.

4. Proposals
