1. Purpose of Report

1.1 The purpose of the report is to have the Committee consider and determine the local public holidays for factories and businesses in North Lanarkshire for the year 2007.

2. Background

2.1 The General Purposes Committee considers annually the dates to be set for local public holidays for factories and businesses. In principle, at its meeting on 7th August, 1996, the Committee agreed that the local public holidays should generally follow the patterns which had been adopted by the constituent authorities to North Lanarkshire and that has been the continuing situation in the past years.

3. Considerations

3.1 By adopting these patterns of local public holidays, the local public holidays in North Lanarkshire in the calendar year 2007 would be as follows -

- Monday 1 and Tuesday 2 January 2007
- Monday 9 April 2007
- Monday 7 and Monday 28 May 2007
- Monday 16 July 2007
- Monday 24 September 2007
- Tuesday 25 and Wednesday 26 December 2007

3.2 The determination of staff holidays is separately dealt with in accordance with an established pattern.

4. Recommendation

4.1 To agree to determine the dates specified in paragraph 3.1 above as the local public holidays for factories and businesses in North Lanarkshire in 2007.
