**1. Introduction**

To advise members of the action taken, after consultation with the Convener, in awarding assistance in respect of a twinning visit to Bron, France and seeking homologation in this regard.

The recommendations of the Working Party on Twinning, approved by the Council, extends to the provision of £50 for the first five days, or part thereof, and £5 per day thereafter for visits to the Council's twin towns.

**3. Consideration**
