**A Meeting of the AIRDRIE AREA COMMITTEE**

**PRESENT**

**The Convener exercised his discretion to vary the Order of Business as hereinafter minuted.**

**BUDGET CONSULTATION - SETTING OF THE COUNCIL TAX UNDER THE GENERAL REVENUE BUDGET FOR 2003/2004**

1. The Director of Finance orally outlined the budget process of the Council which would dictate the level of Council Tax set in North Lanarkshire and highlighted (1) the Council's income and expenditure position; (2) the draft budget for the financial year 2003/2004 including inbuilt service enhancements, cost pressures, and proposed efficiency savings for all departments of the Council; (3) the potential growth for 2003/2004 and the growth priorities, and (4) uncertainties affecting the budget position. He intimated the main issues for consideration and sought the views of the community representatives on the possible growth priorities and efficiency savings which would have an effect on the level of Council Tax set by the Council.

**Decided:** the Committee thanked the Director of Finance for his presentation.

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### **AIRDRIE AREA COMMITTEE - MINUTE**

2. There was submitted the Minute of the meeting of the Airdrie Area Committee held on 12 November 2002.

**Decided:** that the terms of the Minute be noted.

### **COMMUNITY COUNCIL MINUTES**

3. There were submitted the Minutes of the meetings of Greengairs Community Council held on 28 August and 24 September 2002; Monkland Glen Community Council held on 28 October and 25 November 2002; Plains Community Council held on 12 November and 10 December 2002, and Salsburgh Community Council held on 14 November and 12 December 2002 and 9 January 2003.

**Decided:** that the terms of the Minutes be noted.

### **AIRDRIE AND VILLAGES COMMUNITY FORUM - MINUTE**

4. There was submitted the Minute of the meeting of Airdrie and Villages Community Forum held on 16 December 2002.

**Decided:** that the terms of the Minute be noted.

### **RE-OPENING OF CASH COLLECTION OFFICE AT BANK STREET, AIRDRIE**

5. The Income Manager gave an oral presentation on the new Cash Collection Office in Airdrie (1) indicating that previously the Cash Office in Airdrie had operated between premises in Bank Street and Broomknoll Street; (2) outlining the history to the listed building at Bank Street, Airdrie; (3) advising (a) that the Bank Street premises had been refurbished giving a larger public area and disabled access; (b) that the premises would incorporate Council Tax and Benefits enquiries, an interview room and a paypoint facility as well as four teller units, one of which had been adapted for use by the disabled, and (c) that the office at Broomknoll Street would close on Friday, 24 January 2003 with the new premises in Bank Street opening on Monday, 27 January 2003.

**Decided:** that the arrangements for the opening of the Cash Collection Office in Bank Street, Airdrie on 27 January 2003 be noted.

### **REFURBISHMENT OF AIRDRIE LIBRARY, AIRDRIE**

6. The Project Co-ordinator advised the Committee that the premises at Airdrie Library, Airdrie were being refurbished and new shelving was being installed with an expected completion date of the end of January 2003.

**Decided:** that the refurbishment of Airdrie Library, Airdrie be noted.

### **GARTLEA ROAD RAILWAY BRIDGE, AIRDRIE**

7. With reference to paragraph 6 of the Minute of the meeting of this Committee held on 12 November 2002 when the Committee recorded its concern at the delay in receipt of results of Railtrack's
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assessment of Gartlea Road Railway Bridge and agreed that officers explore all options to progress the matter, there was submitted a report dated 6 January 2003 by the Director of Planning and Environment (1) indicating that Railtrack had advised that all parts of Gartlea Road Railway Bridge complied with their loadbearing obligation except for the transverse tie rods; (2) advising that Railtrack would fund a portion of the replacement cost in the region of £5,000 and the remainder of the replacement costs was expected to be in the region of £1 m, and (3) intimating that approval was being sought to enter into negotiations with Railtrack regarding an agreement to replace and widen the bridge deck and that the Council would request Railtrack to deliver the project in the financial year 2004/2005.

The Roads Network Operations Manager (1) referred to the concerns raised by the local member regarding the road conditions in Cairnhill Road, traffic on which is affected by Gartlea bridge; (2) advised the Committee that discussions were ongoing with Scottish Water in relation to the upgrading of the sewer system in this area; (3) indicated that the necessary funding required to be identified to tackle the problem, and (4) intimated that the two projects in relation to the Bridge widening and sewer system required co-ordination to alleviate any resultant traffic congestion. He further indicated that the Department of Planning and Environment kept a flood register containing approximately 80 locations within Airdrie where flooding was a problem and passed the information on to Scottish Water to take action.

**Decided:**

- (1) that it be noted that, subject to Planning and Environment Committee approval, the Council would enter into negotiations with Railtrack with regard to the possibility of an agreement to replace and widen the bridge deck, and
- (2) that it be noted that a further report would be submitted to the Committee on the final estimate and timescale for the project following completion of the feasibility study.

**BUS SERVICE PROVISION TO AIRDRIE AND THE SURROUNDING VILLAGES**

8. With reference to paragraph 4 of the Minute of the meeting of this Committee held on 10 September 2002 when it was agreed, *inter alia*, that information be obtained from Strathclyde Passenger Transport (SPT) on bus service provision from May 2000, there was submitted a report dated 21 January 2003 by the Director of Planning and Environment on levels of bus service provision in the Airdrie area (1) advising that SPT had provided information on levels of bus service provision to the Airdrie area both currently and historically as set out in the report; (2) setting out (a) in Table 1 the changes to services and the numbers of operators providing these services between May 2000 and November 2000; (b) in Table 2 the services provided by First Bus in 2000 and those retained by First Bus and/or provided by other operators in 2002, and (c) in Table 3 the changes to the number of routes serving the settlements within the Airdrie area; (3) intimating that a pilot scheme was being operated for an on-demand rural bus service in the North Lanarkshire area funded from the Rural Transport Grant which allowed use, by residents, of a Dial-a-Bus service between their homes and the main towns in the geographical area as defined in the appendix to the report, and (4) indicating that TravelLine Scotland Public Transport Service was launched in September 2002 to provide accurate and impartial timetable information for travel by rail, air, bus/coach and ferry for any public transport journey within Scotland and from Scotland to main points in the UK.

The Traffic Transportation Team Leader indicated (1) that in addition to the services detailed in Table 1, Salsburgh had five routes in April 2000 which changed to four by November 2000, and (2) that Calderbank had a service operating into the evening.

**Decided:**

- (1) that the intention of representatives of the Council to meet with representatives of SPT to discuss the changes in service provision be noted, and
  - (2) that the terms of the report be otherwise noted.
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### GOOD NEWS

9. There was submitted a report (docketed) dated 24 December 2002 by the Director of Community Services advising of various Good News events and facilities within the Airdrie Area.

**Decided:** that the terms of the report be noted.

### TENDER FOR AUTOMATIC PUBLIC CONVENIENCES FOR AIRDRIE AND COATBRIDGE

10. There was (1) submitted a report dated 14 January 2003 by the Director of Community Services regarding automatic public conveniences for Airdrie and Coatbridge (a) advising that the forthcoming phase of the Airdrie Town Centre Improvement Plan meant that the unit in Airdrie required relocation to an alternative site; (b) intimating that the contract for the lease and maintenance of units had been offered to Healthmatic Limited, Ayr for a period of 15 years, and (c) indicating that the preferred site for the relocated unit at Airdrie was in the car park at Hallcraig Street, and (2) tabled an illustration together with a description of the proposed new facility.

**Decided:** that the terms of the report and illustration be noted.

### AIRDRIE COMMUNITY EDUCATION CENTRE - SAFETY AND SECURITY ISSUES

11. The representatives of Airdrie and Villages Community Forum advised the Committee of concerns regarding the refurbishment of Airdrie Community Education Centre including concerns (1) that there was no office at the entrance to the building, and (2) that there were bars on upstairs windows preventing escape if there was a fire.

The Committee were advised that (1) Phase 1 of the works had been completed and Phase 2, which covered the reception area and external works, was due to commence shortly; (2) that the building would be subject to a Fire Safety inspection prior to completion, and (3) that the Youth Drop-In Centre had been well received and viewed by other local authorities.

**Decided:** that the position in relation to Airdrie Community Education Centre be noted.

### POLICE PRESENCE WHEN YOUTHS EXITING DISCOS IN THE AIRDRIE AREA

12. Inspector Easton (1) advised that discos for the under 18s had been taking place within premises in Airdrie; (2) intimated that during November 2002 disturbances outside these premises had been dealt with by Strathclyde Police; (3) indicated that (a) Strathclyde Police now had a presence at the commencement and close of the disco; (b) CCTV cameras operated within the area, and (c) the owner of the premises had been made aware of the problem, and (4) explained the position regarding the licensing of the premises.

**Decided:** that the Police report in relation to disturbances at discos in the Airdrie area be noted.

### AIRDRIE AREA - POLICING

13. Inspector Easton (1) detailed the Policing incidents in Airdrie and the surrounding villages for the period October to December 2002; (2) outlined the success of the Better Neighbourhood Services Unit in North Airdrie, the Anti-Social Task Force in Holehills, Airdrie, the Community Policing Initiative and cycle patrols, and (3) advised that there was an initiative running to March 2003 to address housebreakings occurring within North Lanarkshire.

**Decided:** that the Police report in relation to policing within Airdrie and the surrounding villages be noted.

**COMMUNITY GRANTS SCHEME - CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS**

14. There was submitted a report dated 6 January 2003 by the Director of Community Services detailing applications of an urgent nature dealt with by the Director of Community Services in conjunction with the Convener of the Committee.

**Decided:** that the action taken by the Director of Community Services, in conjunction with the Convener of the Committee, and the appropriate elected Member, as detailed in Annex 1 to these Minutes, be noted.

**COMMUNITY GRANTS SCHEME - CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS**

15. With reference to paragraph 10 of the Minute of the meeting of this Committee held on 12 November 2002, there was submitted a report dated 8 January 2003 together with a schedule (tabled) by the Director of Community Services detailing applications covering more than one Area Committee boundary, together with continued applications and new applications specific to this Committee.

**Decided:** that, subject to receipt of any outstanding information and subject to the grants not exceeding the amounts requested by the applicant, the applications for Community Grants be dealt with as detailed in Annex 2 to these Minutes.
