**NOTICE OF A PROPOSAL TO HOLD A PUBLIC PROCESSION IN COATBRIDGE ON SATURDAY
9 DECEMBER 2006 BY COATBRIDGE CAMPSIE CLUB APPRENTICE BOYS OF DERRY**

1. There were submitted (1) Notification dated 23 November 2006 of a proposal by the Coatbridge Campsie Club Apprentice Boys of Derry to process in Coatbridge on Saturday, 9 December 2006, and (2) a report dated 27 November 2006 on behalf of the Chief Constable, Strathclyde Police, objecting to the proposal.

The Sub-Committee then heard (1) Superintendent Dorrian and Superintendent Clelland outline the objection to the proposals and table photographs of an area through which it was proposed that the procession would walk, and (2) Mr. Paterson speak in support of the notification and table a paper in support of the proposals.

The Sub-Committee determined to resume consideration in closed session and the notifier and his associate and the representatives of the Police withdrew from the meeting.

After discussion and careful consideration of the representations made, the notifier and his associate and representatives of the Police were re-admitted to the meeting.

Decided: that after discussion and careful consideration of all representations made, the Sub-Committee agreed that no Order be made in terms of Section 63 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.
