

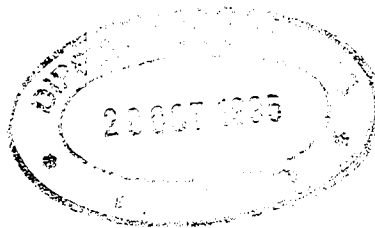

Plans are once again underway for the Chartered Institute of Housing Annual Conference and Exhibition which will be held from 10 – 14 June 1996. This year's theme is 'Housing – Making a Difference'.
